Upon reading total depth, a deviation survey will be submitted for each 500' or less. Total Depth will not be closer than 200' from any boundary or proration unit line, after deepening.

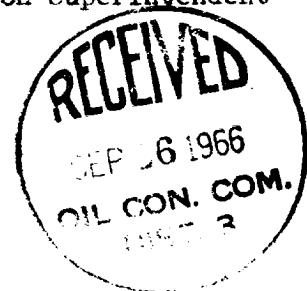

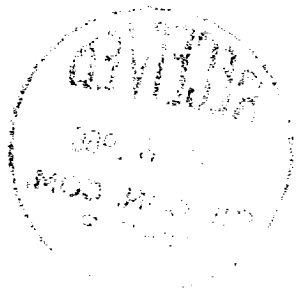

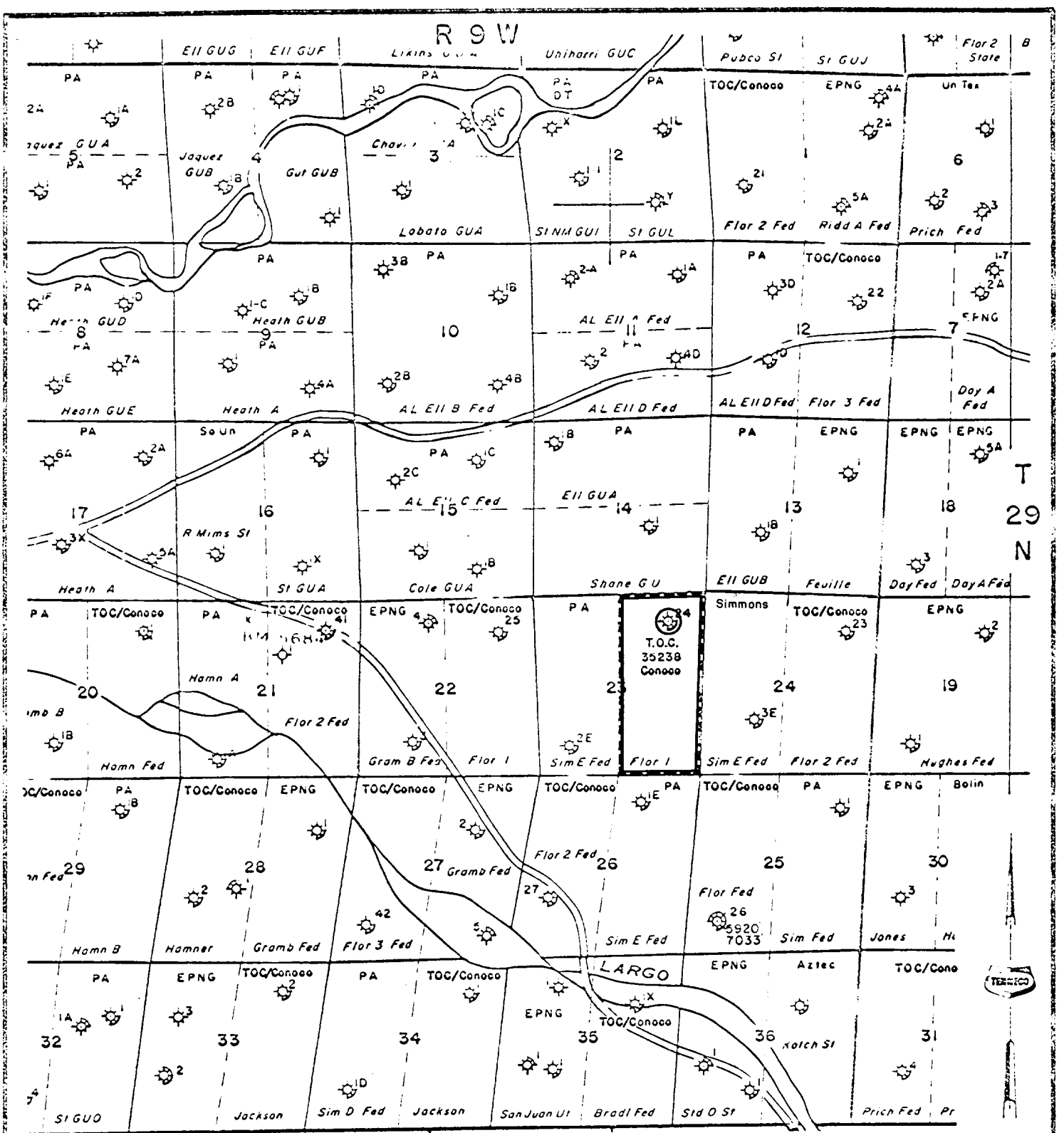
