DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was spudded on March 9, 1956, and on March 11, 1956, 10-3/4" casing was set at 257 feet and cemented with 190 sacks cement. After waiting on cement for 24 hours, casing and water shut off were tested with 500 pounds for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Drilling Operations were resumed.

On March 18, 1956, 7-5/8" casing was set at 2320 feet and cemented with 150 sacks cement. After waiting on cement for 36 hours, casing and water shut off were tested with 1000 pounds for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.
