DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

May 13, 1953 - set 7" casing as reported on May 21, 1953. Moved rotary off.

July 4, 1953 - Moved rotary back. On July 6th, drilled plug. Both before and after drilling plug, tested with 500# pressure for 30 minutes and found all right, there being no indicated drop.

July 9, 1953 - after drilling with gas, shot with 1,560 quarts of solidified nitre glycerin from 5,374 feet to 5,969 feet.

July 10, 1953 - after cleaning out, shut well in to await test, and pipe line connection.

2-7/8" tubing - J. L. 6.50% - 8 rd. thd. - was set at 5,634 feet.
