If lost circulation trouble occurs, 7" casing will be set as needed, cemented with 150 sacks and 6-1/4" hole continued to top of Cliff House where 5-1/2" - 17" casing will be set, cemented

If changes in the above plans become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 5,550 feet.

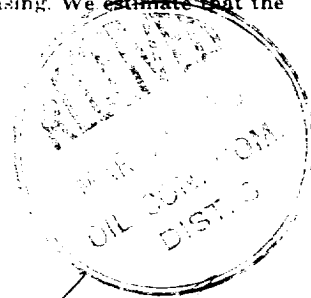

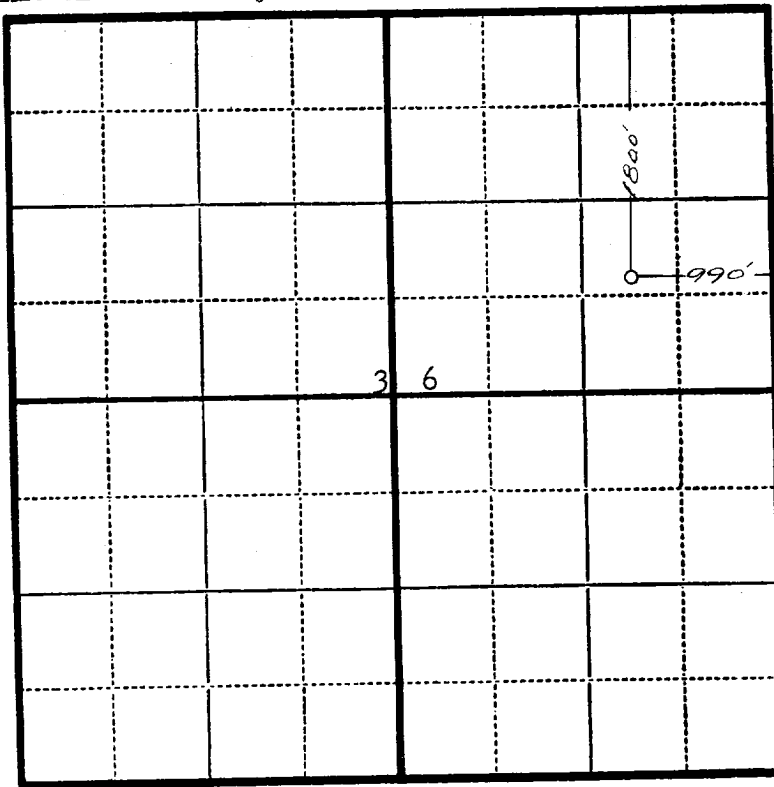
