

Gentlemen:

Please consider this letter as a petition for an unorthodox location covering the well and situation discussed below.

The Peters No. 1, to be located 700 feet from the North line and 950 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 30 North, Range 7 West, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, will fall on Federal lands, Lease No. Santa Fe 079001. An orthodox location would place this well within the confines of Francis Creek. This creek is due to be flooded by waters backing up from the presently proposed San Juan River Dam. Surrounding terrain, and surface conditions of the creek bed itself, offer undue hazards to an orthodox location.

El Paso Natural Gas Company is operator of this lease and all offsetting acreage under operating agreements filed with the Bureau of Land Management, except for Section 10, Township 30 North, Range 7 West. Section 10 falls within the Northeast Blanco Unit operated by Blackwood and Nichols Company.

Attached to this letter are the approval from Blackwood and Nichols, the approval from U. S. Geological Survey and a certified plat showing the proposed location and surface conditions.


