Reference is made to the following: (i) your application dated February 27, 1998; and, (ii) to the records of the Division in Santa Fe: all concerning Mallon Oil Company's request for a non-standard 95.40-acre gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the East Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool:

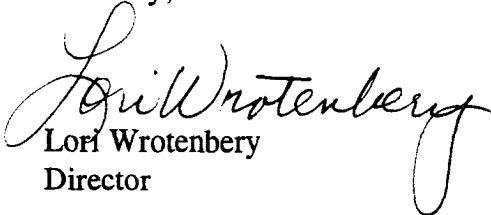
RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Irregular Section 30: Lots 3 and 4.

It is our understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to the proposed Jicarilla 464-30 Well No. 9 (API No. 30-039-25789), to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location 400 feet from the South line and 800 feet from the West line (Unit N) of said irregular Section 30.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rules 104.F and 104.D(2) of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division").

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rules 104.F(2) and 104.D(2)(b), the above-described unorthodox gas well location and 95.40-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit are hereby approved.
