Dear Mr. Prather:

Reference is made to your application dated March 29, 1999 for an exception to the well location requirements provided within the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool," as promulgated by New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") Order No. R-10987, for a non-standard infill gas well location in an existing standard 320-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Dakota Pool comprising the W/2 of Section 23, Township 30 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This unit is currently dedicated to Phillips Petroleum Company's San Juan "30-5" Unit Well No. 83 (API No. 30-039-22728), located a standard gas well location 1480 feet from the South line and 950 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 23.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 104.F and 605.B.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F(2), the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox infill gas well location in Section 23 is hereby approved:

San Juan "30-5" Unit Well No. 83-M 230' FNL & 1440' FWL (Unit C)

Further, both of the aforementioned San Juan "30-5" Unit Well Nos. 83 and 83-M and existing gas spacing and proration unit will be subject to all existing rules,

Phillips Petroleum Company (Phillips) as Operator of the captioned well, respectfully requests administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for said well.

Phillips proposes to drill the San Juan 30-5 Unit #83M well at a location of 230' FNL & 1440' FWL of Section 23-30N-5W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This well will be located in the Basin Dakota and Blanco Mesaverde Pools and will have the W/2 of Section 23 designated as the drillblock. This location is necessary due to topographical considerations and prevention of unnecessary resource damage and is at the request of the Carson National Forest. For your benefit in reviewing this request, we are providing the following:

- 1. A letter from the Jicarilla Ranger District, Carson National Forest
- 2. An APD packet for the subject well (Form C-102 included)
- 3. A topographical plat of the area
- 4. A nine section plat exhibiting offset operators

This drill block is located within the confines of the San Juan 30-5 Unit and is completely surrounded by drillblocks operated by Phillips. Per the District OCD office in Aztec, it is our understanding that the 20 day notice period can be waived due to Phillips operating all offsetting drillblocks. We respectfully ask that if possible, the waiting period be waived and this request be expedited.

The Jicarilla Ranger District, Carson National Forest is requesting you apply for an unorthodox location as follows, as discussed by your company representative and Camela Hooley of this office:

SJ 30-5 #111, T30N R5W Sec.13, 860'FSL/1375'FWL SJ 30-5 #112, T30N R5W Sec.12, 1190'FSL/1730'FEL SJ 30-5 #83M, T30N R5W Sec.23, 230'FNL/1440'FWL

The mineral operator is required to comply with other applicable regulations such as the Endangered Species Act and the Archeological Resources Protection Act under 36CFR228.112(c). The operator is also required under 36CFR228.108(c) to minimize or prevent damage to surface resources. The Carson National Forest Management Plan states that surface resource impacts will be minimized when administering mineral resources.

The following conditions apply which require an unorthodox location:

#112 Archeological resources prevent locating the well in an orthodox location.

#111,#112,83M Topography prevents locating the well in an orthodox location.

Threatened/endangered species concerns prevent locating the well in an orthodox location.

#111,#112,#83M Prevention of unneccesary resource damage requires the location be unorthodox.

(Previously disturbed area or existing road available outside the drilling window.)


