We are returning two copies of Form C-128, New Mexico Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat.

Our Dakota spacing order requires that a standard unit for Dakota production be a legal half-section containing 320 acres more or less. The half-section dedicated may be either North, South, East or West. I am unable to determine from the plat you have submitted what acreage you are dedicating but it appears possible that you intended your dedication to be the the East Half of the Northwest Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 31. This dedication could not be made without calling a hearing before the Commission for the formation of a non-standard unit.

If it was your intention to dedicate the West Half of Section 31, please outline this acreage and fill in the total number of dedicated acres.
