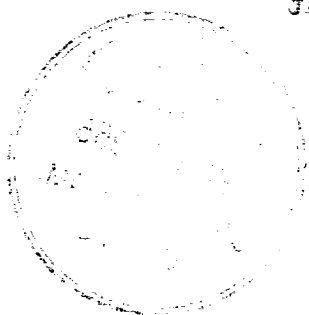

and proposed location is as near to the center of that




