ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Southern Union Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on February 10, 1959, for permission to dually complete its Armenta Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Farmington formation.

Now on this 2nd day of March, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

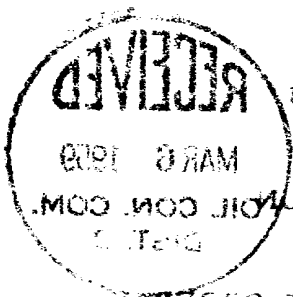
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southern Union Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Armenta Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Farmington formation, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Southern Union Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on February 19, 1959, for permission to dually complete its Armenta Well No. 1, located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Farmington formation.

Now on this 2nd day of March, 1959, the Secretary-Treasurer finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that the operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste of oil in fair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southern Union Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Armenta Well No. 1, located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Farmington formation, through parallel averaging, tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section 7, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-12114.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take proper care and tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Delinquency Test Period for the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool.
