At your request I have certified the following facts from the New Mexico Oil Commission records:

The Paul Case #1 J.M. Valdez well located 1710 feet from the South and 110 feet from the East lines of Section 24-29N-11W was spudded October 8, 1957 and completed November 15, 1957 as a producing gas well in the Fruitland formation through perforations located from 1510' to 1532'.

This well was first delivered to a pipeline on February 11, 1958 and has produced continuously since that time.
