The Federal land is assigned by Elmer E. Elliott to Locke-Taylor Drilling Company, Durango, Colorado. The Federal permit is No. 06093, Santa Fe. The objective is the Pictured Cliffs sand, estimated at 1200' feet.**

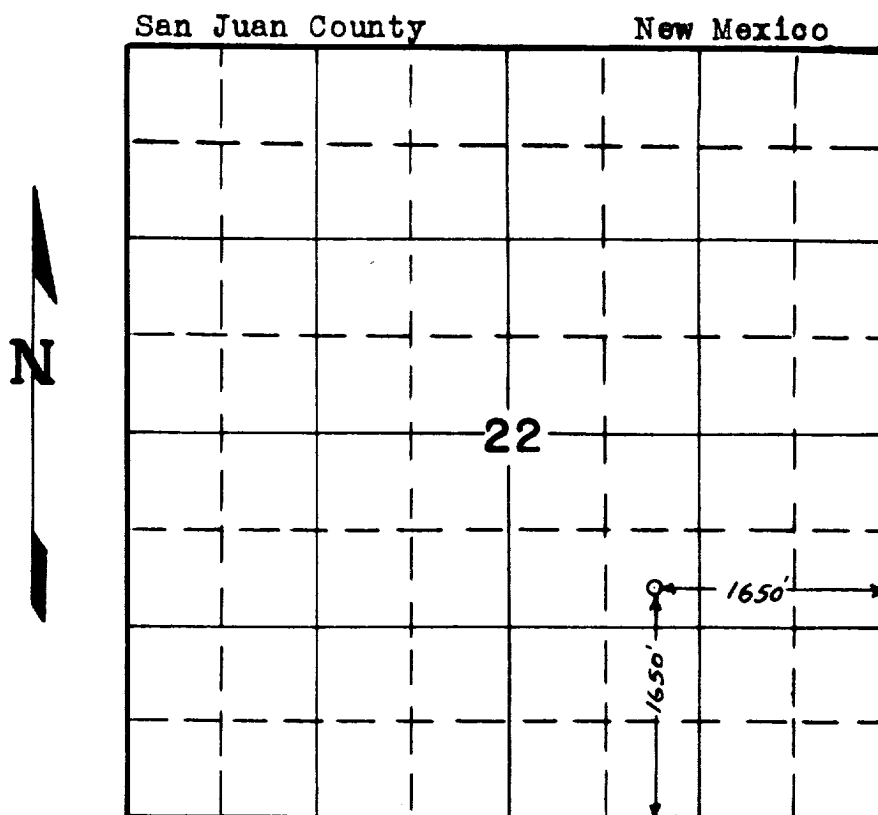
