Gentlemen:

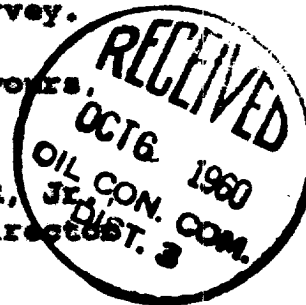

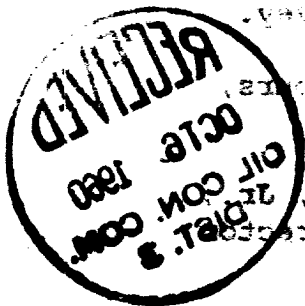
