On December 28, 1957, a 5" 15 pound liner was run with Beach-Ross pack off type liner hanger and set at 5486'-7035' with 210 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, casing was tested with 1100 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
