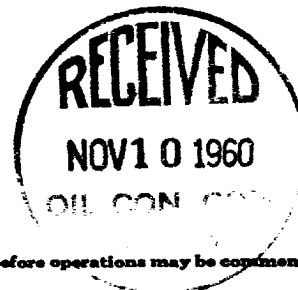

## DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 12-1/4" hole on November 4, 1960, and drilled to 212'. Set 8-1/8" casing at 212' with 160 sacks regular cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Circulated 15 sacks cement. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 300 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 212' and resumed drilling operations.
