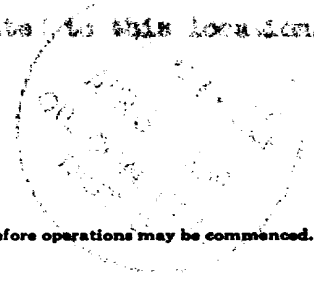

DETAILS OF WORK

Proposed to: Set 250' of 1 1/2" casing and cement with 150 lb. cement. Drill through fractured little formation to an approximately total depth of 210'. Set 1 1/2" casing to total depth with 75 lb. cement. Perforate casing and sand-test for flow of oil, gas and water. Run 1" signal line.

The 150 lb. casing of 150 acres, has been dedicated to this location.

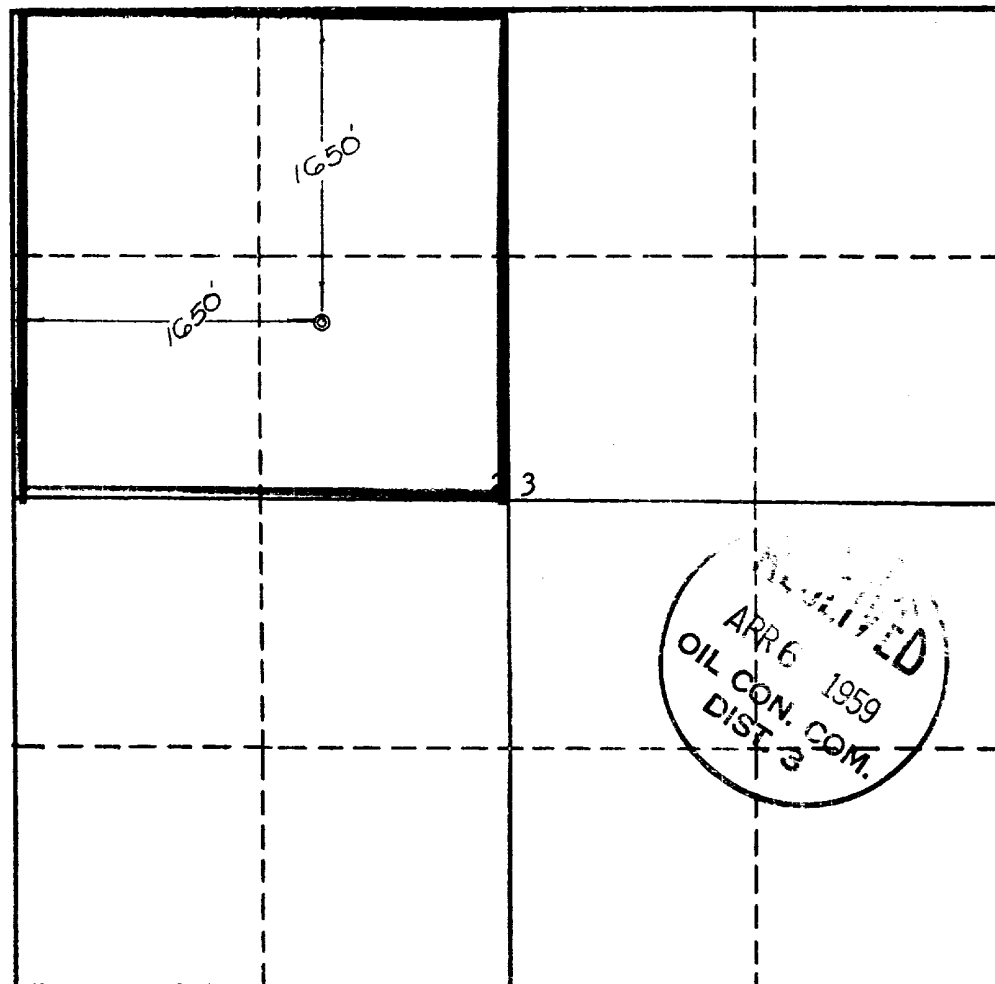
