Gentlemen:

On December 3, 1964 copies of Federal Form 9-330, "Well Completion Report" were filed with this office indicating that the above well had been completed in the Gallup formation as a producing oil well.

Commission Form C-104, "Request for Allowable" and Form C-110 "Authorization to Transport" were never filed with this office for approval. Therefore the transporter of the oil has never been authorized and an allowable has never been assigned on this well. On February 18, 1965 a notice of over-production was received in this office from our statistical section in Santa Fe indicating that production for the above well had been filed by Miami Oil Producers, Incorporated. This over-production report indicated that the well had produced 1666 barrels of oil through December. The report also indicated that McWood Corporation as transporter had run 1302 barrels. As this oil was produced and run without an allowable the oil is all illegal oil under our rules. We are, therefore, directing that no further oil be produced or run from this lease until it has been decided by the Oil Conservation Commission what further action should be taken.

We are enclosing under separate cover a book of New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations and direct your attention to Rule 801, Page 49; Rule 1109, Page 58; To Section 65-3-18 of the Statutes, Page 81; and Section 65-3-27, on Page 85 relating to penalties for violation.

Effective January 1, 1965 Commission Forms C-104 and C-110 have been combined and the combined form is now numbered C-104. We are also sending a supply of these forms for your use. Our present records indicate that the operator of the above well is Zoller and Danneburgh. If it is your intention to transfer this well to Miami Oil Producers, Inc, Form C-104 as filed should so indicate and the form should be checked both for a new well and for change of ownership.
