

**Gentlemen:**



Please advise me of the status of the Francis L. Harvey and Capital Counsellors Bunce-Federal Well No. 1.

If the operators did not have a rig on the location and physical operations to rework the well commenced in the well bore by November 15, 1963, I will advise them that the well must be plugged, that they must first have a minimum plugging program approved by your office, and that plugging operations must be completed on or before December 15, 1963.
