DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On April 22, 1956 well was perforated with four jet shots per foot from 1375 feet to 1388 feet.

Well was then acidized with 500 gallons 15% mud acid, formation broke at 1600 pounds.

Then well was sand fraced with 20,000 gallons water and 28,500 pounds regular sand.
Maximum pump pressure was 1250 pounds. Injection rate was 47.5 barrels per minute.
Preliminary test after frac was 5210 MCPPD.
