Gentlemen:

After our telephone conversation this morning I have searched our records on the above well and find that it was originally drilled by Douglas Corporation and completed as a gas well in the Aztec Fruitland Pool. Nothing has been filed indicating transfer of ownership to Texota Oil Company.

Production reports have been filed for the months of January, February, and March, 1959. The only production report outstanding at this time is the April report. We are enclosing a supply of Form C-110 and Form C-115. The C-110 should be filed in quadruplicate by you showing change of ownership. Please give date of transfer in the "Remarks" column. It will also be necessary that a \$5000 one-well plugging bond be filed with the Oil Conservation Commission, Box 871, Santa Fe, N.M. before the transfer is approved.

Form C-115 should be filled out for the month of April and distributed as follows: Original to Oil Commission, Santa Fe; one copy to the transporter involved; one copy to Oil Conservation Commission, Proration Office, Box 2045, Hobbs, New Mexico; and one copy to this office.
