DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to workover USG Section 19 Well No. 13 as follows:

1. Move in and rig up workover rig.
2. Kill well and pull tubing.
3. Run correlation log.
4. Check bottom plug.
5. Test Pennsylvanian perforated zones to determine fluid content of producing intervals.
6. Squeeze water bearing zones as indicated and test for water shut off.
7. Re-perforate and stimulate if necessary, as determined from test data and return well to producing.
