Gentlemen:

The above well was temporarily abandoned by your company November 1, 1957 at a total depth of 767'. 4 1/2" casing was cemented at 756 feet with 100 sacks of cement.

At that time you stated it was your intention to either recondition or deepen this well. As we have received no further information and have received no production reports we presume that it is your intention to permanently plug and abandon this well. We are enclosing a supply of Form C-102. Please submit this form in triplicate indicating your plugging plan. We are directing that the actual plugging be done within the next 60 days.
