DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 12-1/4" hole on November 29, 1960, and drilled to 205'. Set 8-5/8" casing at 205' with 120 sacks cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Circulated 35 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 350 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 205' and resumed drilling operations.

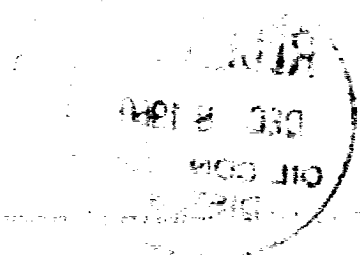
