DETAILS OF WORK

Refer to Well History dated 6-1-62. Drilled to 6728' TD and ran RA log. Ran 210 joints 2 7/7" tubing, landed @ 6598'. Swabbed 6 - 8 bbls. water and mud per hour w/steady gas blow (50-100 MCFD). Acidized w/1000 gallons. Swabbed 5 BO & 39 BW in 12 hours. Pulled tubing and cleaned out well and acidized w/2000 gals. MCA. Swabbed 10 bbls. oil and 185 bbls. water in 8 hours. Released rotary rig 6-6-62. Ran B-J pump, landed @ 3503' and placed well on pump 6-14-62. Pumped 7 BO & 486 BW in 24 hours. Pulled pump and tubing. Ran tubing and rods and placed well on pump 6-20-62. Well pumped 309 bbls. water w/trace of oil in 24 hours. Shut engine down to flow well. Well flowed 59 bbls. water w/trace of oil per day on 7-15-62. Well shut-in 7-16-62 and held for safe water disposal well or plug back to Hogback zone for gas well at future date.
