1. Cement 16" 42.8# casing at 300'
2. Rathole 11" hole ahead to 2300'
 - a) If water flows are encountered open hole to 13-3/4" and cement 10-3/4" 40.3# casing to surface. Drill 9-7/8" hole into top of Hermosa (5700'). Cement 7-5/8" 26.4# casing. Drill and core 6-3/4" to T.D. (7800').
 - b) If no problems are encountered down to 2300' then drill 11" hole into top of Hermosa (5700'). Cement 8-5/8" combination weight string. Drill and core 7-5/8" to T.D. (7800'). Test all significant shows.
3. Balance of program to follow.

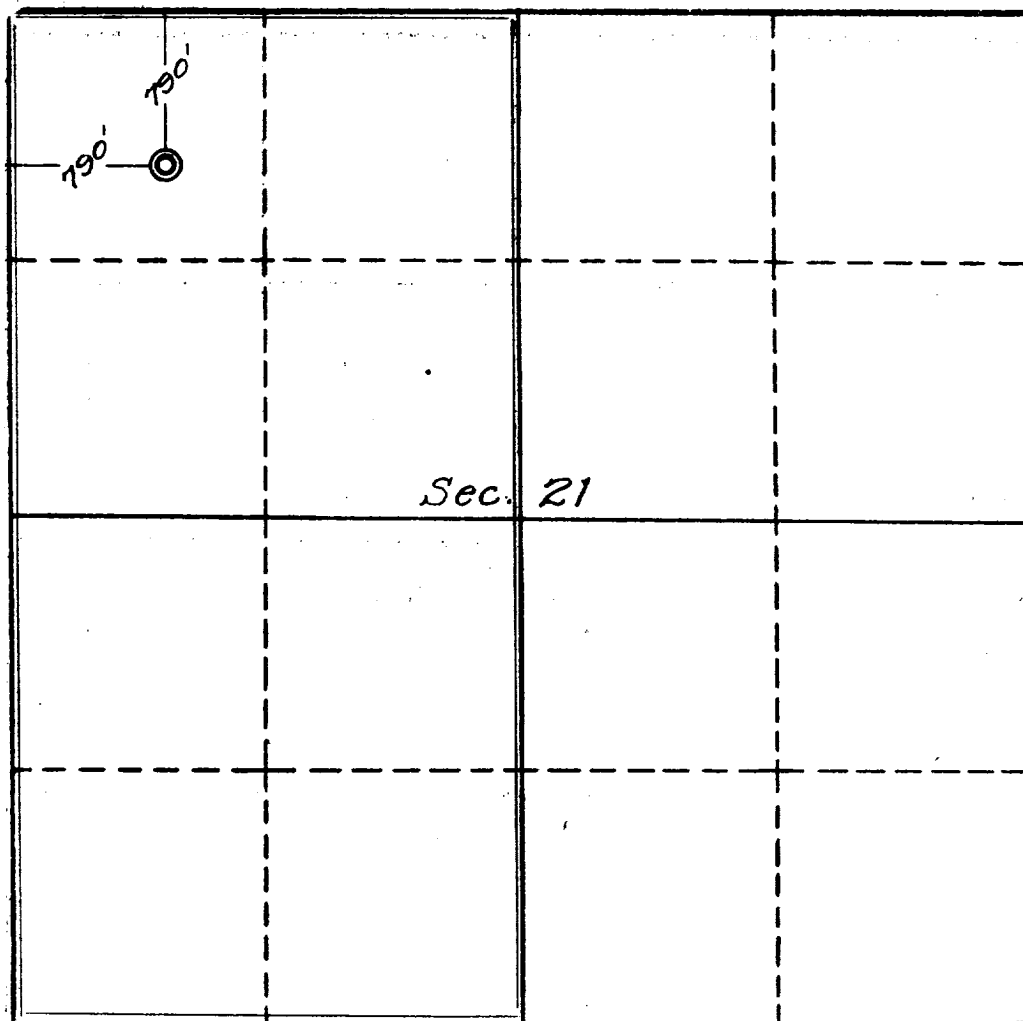

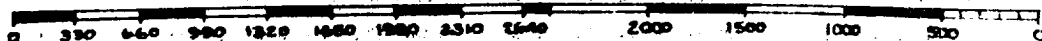
