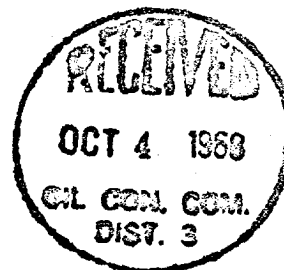

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for extension of time in which to flare or vent low pressure casinghead gas from your Fruitland Navajo Well No. 2 located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 15 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-2103, you are hereby authorized to flare gas from the above-described well, for an indefinite period unless gas production is greatly increased.

In the event gas production increases, please furnish the Santa Fe office of the Commission with a re-evaluation of the feasibility of eliminating the flaring or venting of gas from the above-described well. Failure to do so will subject the well to cancellation of allowable.
