Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

9/7/56. After drilling to 2068' with rotary rig, (top of Pictured Cliffs 2047') set 60 joints 5-1/2" OD 13.7# EW casing and 5 joints 5-1/2" OD 15.5# EW casing at 2052' RKB with 100 sacks cement. Moved off.

9/10/56. After moving cable tools, four hour test showed no water. Drilled to 2127' and loaded 150 quarts solidified nitro-glycerin from 2068' to 2127' - tamped with 10' gravel. Shot went off 7:30 P.M. 9/12/56. On 9/14/56 sand fraced from 2052' to 2127' with 17,750 gallons diesel oil and 30,000# sand. Flushed with 2,250 gallons diesel. Breakdown 200#. Injection 37 barrels per minute.

9/15/56 - Ran 95 joints (2096') of 1" tubing - landed at 2104' RKB. Shut well in to await potential test and pipe line connection.
