**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Woodrow Stiles made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 16, 1960 for permission to dually complete its Ransom Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Astec-Fruitland Pool and the production of gas from the Astec-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

NOW, on this 12th day of January, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, Woodrow Stiles, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Ransom Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Astec-Fruitland Pool and the production of gas from the Astec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, through the casing-tubing annulus and tubing respectively.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

**PROVIDED FURTHER,** That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Astec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, or as directed by the Secretary-Director of the Commission.

POOL and the production of gas from the Aztec-PICTURED CLIFFS  
POOL, through the casing-tubing annulus and tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate,  
and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of section  
V, Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper  
leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the  
Annual Deliverability Test period for the Aztec-PICTURED CLIFFS  
POOL, or as directed by the Secretary-Director of the Commission.
