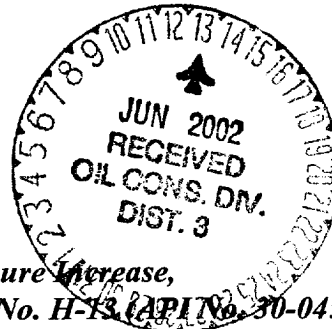

**RE: Injection Pressure Increase,
Navajo Tribal No. H-13 (API No. 30-045-08280)
San Juan County, New Mexico**



Reference is made to your request received in this office on June 6, 2002, to increase the surface injection pressure on the above-referenced well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on May 30, 2002. After reviewing this test, we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

Well and Location	Maximum Surface Injection Pressure
Navajo Tribal No. H-13	550 PSIG
Located in NE/4 SW/4, Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 14 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.	

This maximum surface injection pressure limit is valid only through the existing 2 3/8 inch plastic coated injection tubing.

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
