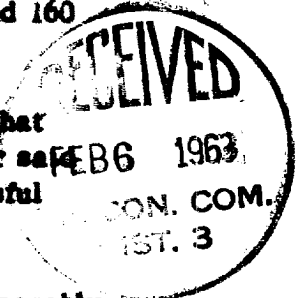

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Products Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval for an exception until April 1, 1963, to the "no-flare" provision of Order No. R-2103 for the Brimhall #1 Well located 2,580' from the South line and 1,980' from the West line of Section 17, Township 29 North, Range 14 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Brimhall #1 Well was completed as an oil well in the Gallup formation on October 11, 1962.
2. That said well is capable of producing 25 barrels of oil and 160 MCF of gas per day to a pipeline.
3. That said well is located North of the San Juan River and that Applicant has attempted to obtain a pipeline connection for said well with Gas Leasing Corporation but has been unsuccessful in such attempt to this date.
4. That the granting of the exception requested herein is reasonably necessary to prevent waste and to prevent undue hardship on the Applicant.
