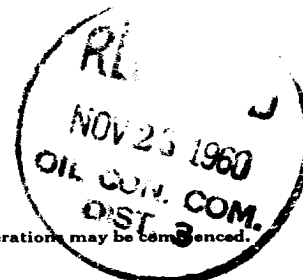
DETAILS OF WORK

November 13, 1960 - spudded well at 2:00 A. M.

After drilling to 356' RKB in 12" hole - set 11 joints (335.88') of 8-5/8" OD 24# J-55 casing at 348' RKB with 225 sacks 2% calcium chloride. Circulated to surface.

Continued drilling with rotary rig after cement had set.
