## DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Notice of intention to drill this well filed by Frederick P. Haurch under date of November 24, 1958 and approved by U.S.G.S. on November 24, 1958. Mr. Haurch contracted with Sun Jam Drilling Company to drill the well, and under date of January 15, 1959 the Gulf Oil Corporation, Box 8097, Denver, Colorado designated Sun Jam Drilling Company (Incorporated in Delaware) as the "Operator" and cancelled the designation issued to Frederick P. Haurch, 515 Gulf States Bldg., Dallas, Texas under date of November 7, 1958.

It was found necessary to set surface casing to 265' - and it is proposed to set an intermediate string of 9-5/8" casing at about 2165'. Anticipated total depth is still 7200' or 130' into Mississippian formation, testing all shows of oil or gas. If commercial production obtained, 5-1/2" casing will be set on bottom - perforated - and sand oil fractured. Testing will be run for production.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
