DETAILS OF WORK

According to our telephone conversation of the 23rd, we wish to change plan for cementing pipe on top of the Point Look-out land stamp which was encountered at 4000' pipe is now set at 4005', getting a perfect water shut-off, but is stuck so tight that I have been unable to pull it to cement, in spite of all my efforts to the contrary, pulled 45" tension in the pipe and worked it for two days, took hold in bottom with trip spear but was unable to move it, so am asking to be allowed to drill sand and if production is encountered to gun perforate and cement in this way.

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I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
