DETAILS OF WORK

Pulled rods and tubing 10-22-63. Set cast iron bridge plug at 800'. Perforated 4 jets per foot 765'-768'. Unable to break down. Reperforated same interval. Sandfraced with 10,000# sand, 400# "ADOMITE AQUA" additive, and 14,900 gallons water. Ran 734' of 2 3/8" tubing. Ran pump. Pumped water with estimated 4 MCF gas per day. Turned to pit. Well dropped from report 11-2-63. Ran Schlumberger Neutron log; log indicates well not perforated in best zone. Perforated with 4 jets per foot 766'-772'. Hard gas blow after perforating. Ran 24 joints 2 7/8" tubing, landed at 752' with tubing pump. Ran rods. Put on pump 12-10-63. Well failed to pump. Parted rods. Pulled pump. Swabbed water. Ran new pump. Well pumping all water - no oil or gas. Shut-in. Will be used in the future as a waterflood injection. If not, the well will be plugged as required by law.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

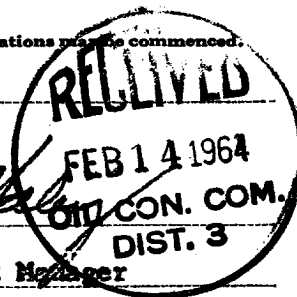
