13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

Meridian Oil obtained operatorship of this well from Mobil Oil & Gas on August 1, 1992. At that time, the well was shut in due to unsafe surface equipment. Currently Meridian is evaluating the installation of central compression for this well's lateral pipeline, which would affect the type of equipment purchase for the well. Upon completion of this evaluation, Meridian will install the proper and safe equipment and return this well to production before April 1994.
