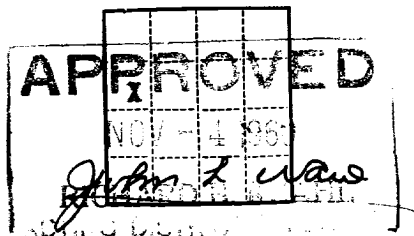

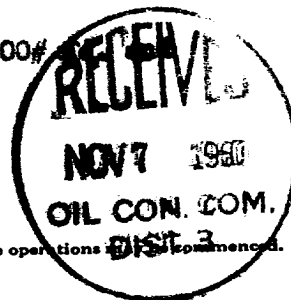

Perforate and frac Dakota fm. selectively w/100,000# 100,000 gal. water, cleanout well and run tbg.



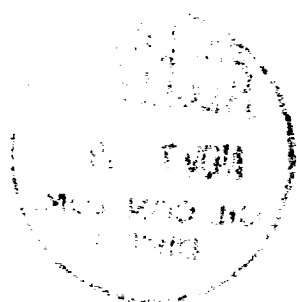

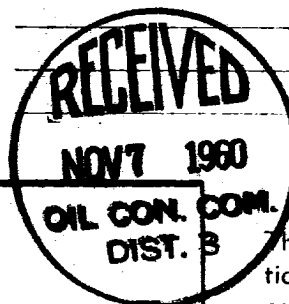
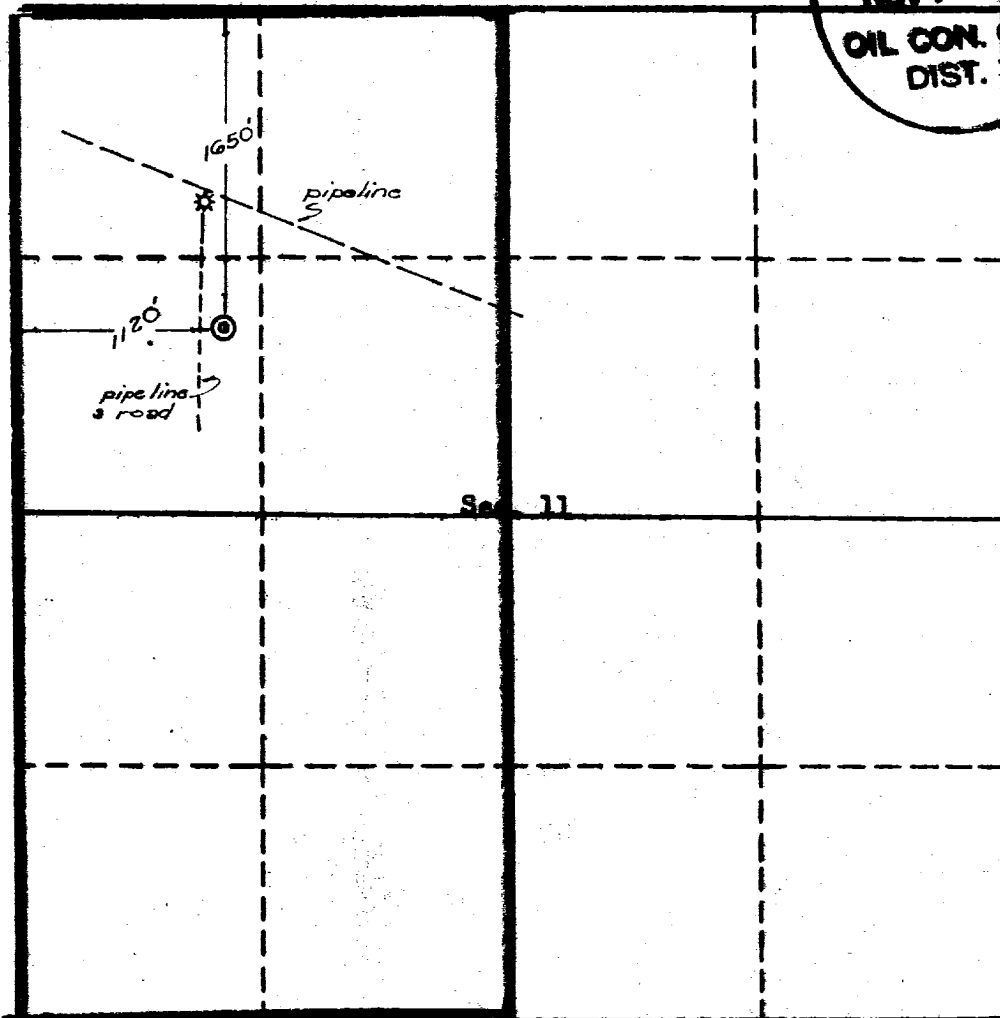
