Spudded with rotary tools 3-30-62. Drilled 12 1/4" hole to 320' RB. Reamed to 17 3/4" to 320'. Ran 11 joints 13 3/8" O.D. surface casing landed at 320' RB. Cemented with 300 sacks regular w/2% HA₅ w/full returns. WOC. Tested w/500 psi - held 30 min. OK. Drilling ahead on 4-1-62.
