DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 1-23-62. Drilled 12 1/4" hole to 310'. Reamed 17 1/2" to 306'. Ran 10 joints 13 3/8", H-40, 48# casing, landed at 306'. Cemented w/ 300 sacks, good returns 1-24-62. Drilled 12 1/4" hole to 4512' and ran 142 joints of 9 5/8"-36# casing. Cemented through shoe w/ 150 sacks regular mixed w/ 150 sacks stratocrete followed w/ 75 sacks regular. Cemented through stage collar at 997' w/ 130 sacks regular. Closed collar w/ 1600 psi 2-6-62. Drilled with air to 6550'. Ran 70 joints, 2194', 7" O.D., 23#, J-55, liner, landed at 6532' RB. Cemented w/ 140 sacks regular and 140 cu.ft. stratocrete followed by 100 sacks regular. Drilled 6 1/8" hole with mud to 6660'. Ran 205 joints (6494') 2 7/8" tubing. Completed open hole 6527'-6660' in Pennsylvanian. IP-41 barrels oil in 5 hours, no water on 17/64" choke. Gravity 44°. GOR, 1373.
