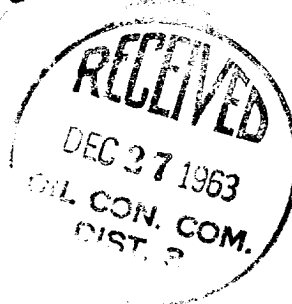

Spudded 12-11-63 with cable tools. Drilled sand & shale to 36'; set 36' of 9 5/8" casing and cemented to surface with 16 sacks neat cement. WOC. Drilled sand, shale, bentonite & limestone to 964'. Ran logs. Drilled sand 964'-974', no shows. Ran 31 joints 5 1/2" casing, landed at 974' and cemented with 200 sacks. WOC 24 hours 12-24-63. Perforated 810'-814' with 4 jets per foot. Waterfraced with 10,000# sand and 10,000 gallons water & 500# "ADONITE AQUA" additive. Ran 27 joints 2 7/8" tubing, landed at 816'. Ran 2 1/2 x 2" x 14' pump with Martin plunger. Released rig 12-24-63. Testing.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
