Spudded 6-12-62 and drilled 12 1/4" hole w/rotary tools to 310' RB. Reamed hole to 17 1/4" to 310' RB. Ran 9 joints 13 3/8" casing, landed @ 310' and cemented w/325 sacks. WOC 18 hours. Tested casing @ 600 psi for 15 minutes - held OK. Drilling ahead in sand and shale.
