

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Aztec Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 6, 1972, for permission to dually complete its Hare Well No. 15 located in Unit M of Section 3, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 26th day of March, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Hare Well No. 15 located in Unit M of Section 3, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Messavere Pool and the Basin-Bakora Pool.

Now, on this 25th day of March, 1937, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 113-2 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset wells have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed well completion will not cause waste and injure correlative rights;
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed well completion are feasible and conformant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Artes Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to drill a well in its Hare Well No. 12 located in Unit M of Section 3, Township 19 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M. San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Messavere Pool and the Basin-Bakora Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 113-2.

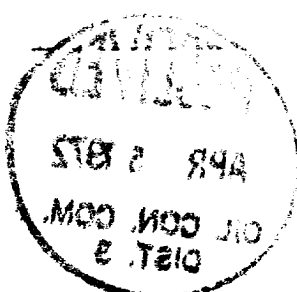
INWITNESS WHEREOF, That applicant shall take proper leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.
