Breakdown Pressure 1050 lbs. Injection Rate 32.7 barrels per minute. Ran 2290' of 1" tubing landed at 2300. S I G April 6, 1956. Tested well April 13, 1956. Gauged 2950 MCF, S I G SITP 658 lbs.
