Dear Mr. Arnold:

Am in receipt of your letter of October 6th.

In my letter of September 11th I made a request to the effect that if and when it appears that Mr. Martin is no longer producing and that the well has been abandoned and you find it necessary to bring plugging action, we would appreciate being notified to that effect and given 60 or perhaps 90 days in which to investigate the well's possibility and submit our own appraisal.

I have been told that the well is not running and that from all appearances no one has been around the well for some time.

In the meantime we were of the opinion that we could make no definite arrangements as regards our taking over the well until we find that the well has been abandoned and that we are given permission to take over.

Am writing Mr. Martin today to find out if possible what he intends to do.

In the meantime if I have not made my request in proper form I would appreciate being corrected and set right.
