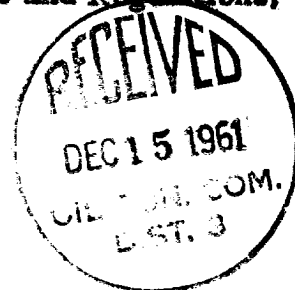

The above referred to well is being completed at this time in the Dakota formation, and the unit assigned to this well will be the E/2 of Section 4, 29N-11W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Forms C-128 have already been filed by our representative, Mr. Tom Dugan of Farmington, New Mexico. However the E/2 of this section contains only 305.89 acres according to the General Land Office Survey.

Therefore we respectfully request approval of this application for a non-standard gas unit in the Dakota producing interval without notice and hearing under Rule 1(B) of the Special Rules and Regulations, as set forth in Order R-1287.



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The E/2 of this Section is being communitized as to the Dakota formation only for this well.
