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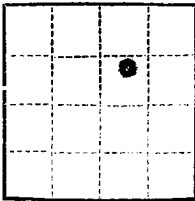

Propose to: Set 100 ft. of 8 5/8" casing at 100 ft. with 100 sacks cement. Drill through Pictured Cliffs formation to an approximate total depth of 2415 ft. Set 5 1/2" casing through Pictured Cliffs. Perforate Pictured Cliffs with 4 shots per ft. Sand-water frac with approximately 40,000 gallons water and 40,000 lbs. sand. Run 1" tubing to approximately 2365 ft. The production unit of 162 acres, NE 1/4, is assigned.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

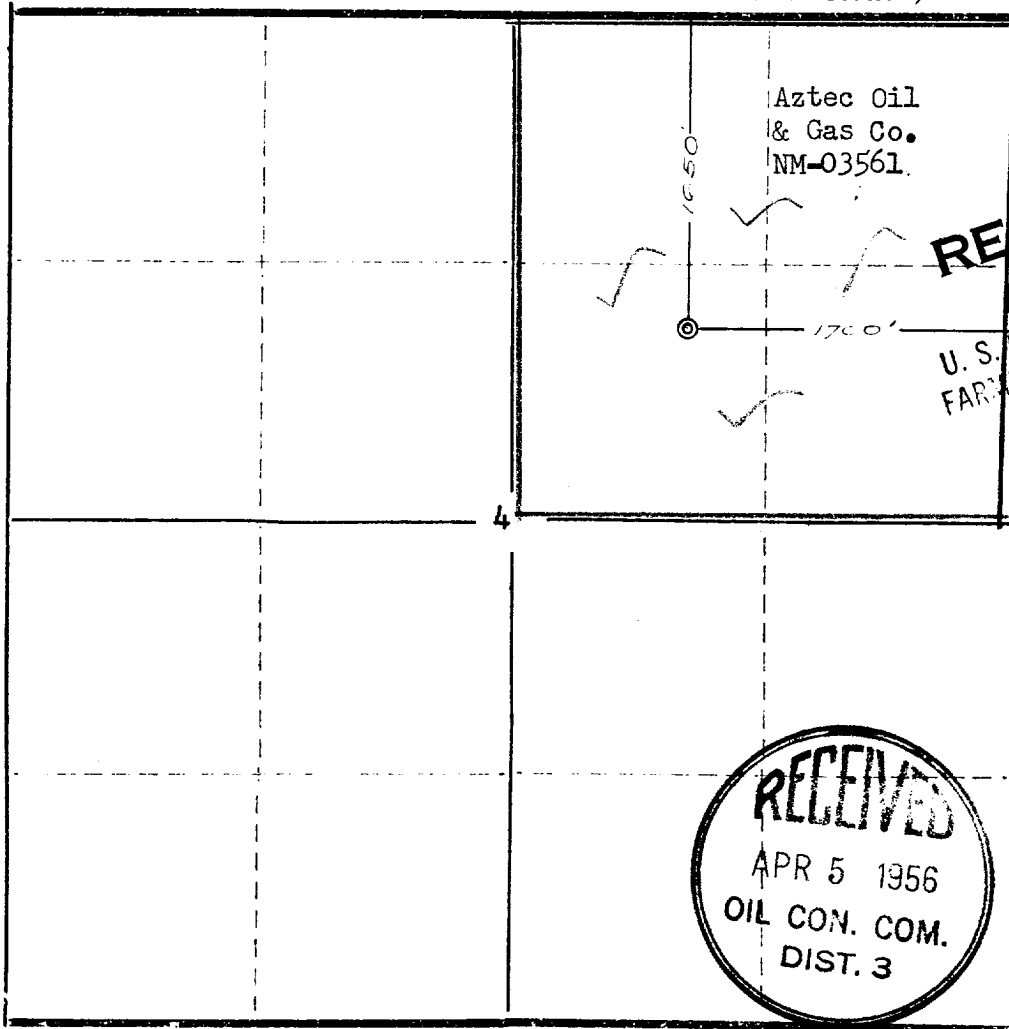
