Tentative procedure as follows: Drill a 10-3/4" hole to approx. 200', set 8-5/8" J-55 surface casing with sufficient cement to circulate. Drill a 7-5/8" hole to approximately 6100' (TD), set 4-1/2" J-55, 10.5# Special Tested 4400# production casing w/250 sz. cement.

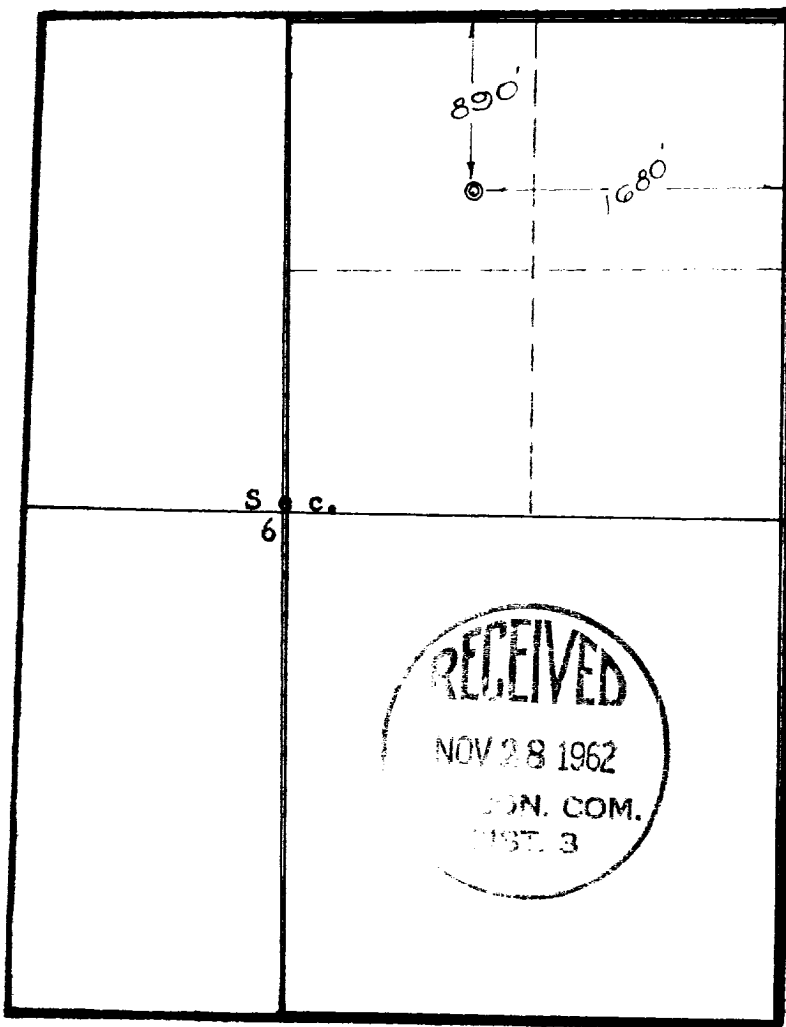
