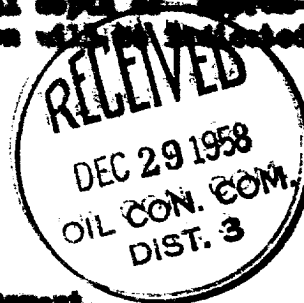
DETAILS OF WORK

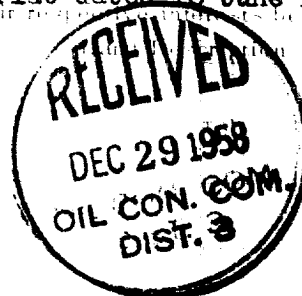

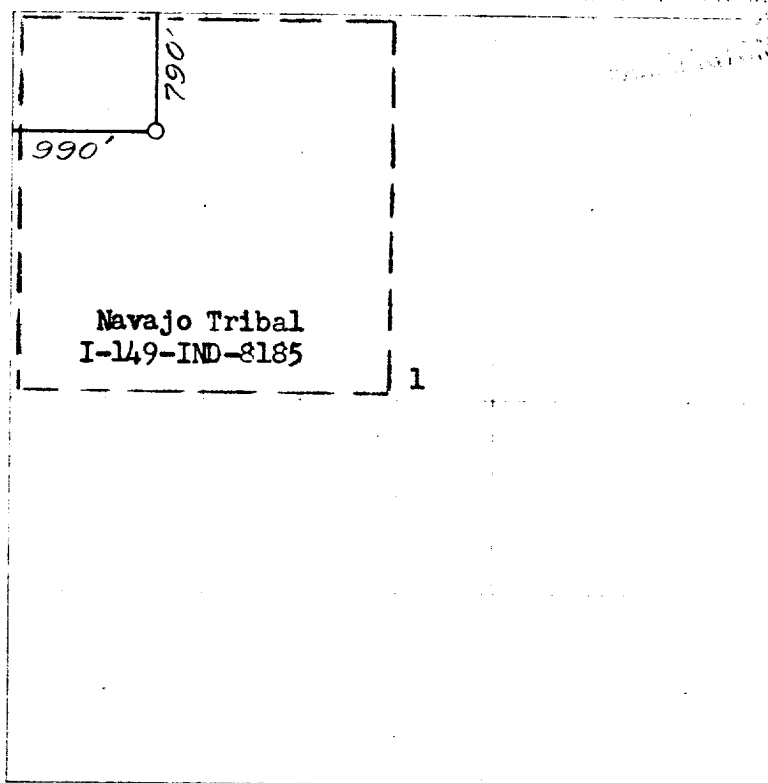
