DETAILS OF WORK

Navajo "C" Well No. 1 was spudded on January 1, 1959 and on January 6, 1959, 16" casing was set at 361' with 400 sacks of gel cement followed by 100 sacks neat cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut off were tested with 600 pounds pressure for thirty minutes which held with no drop in pressure. Reduced hole to 13-3/4" at 361' and resumed drilling operations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
