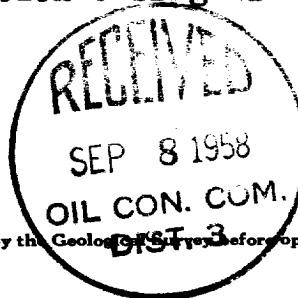

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well with rotary tools to an estimated depth of 7200', to test the Pennsylvanian formation. Approximately 200' of 10 3/4" surface casing will be run and cemented, and if unconsolidated sands or water flows are encountered, approximately 2800' of 7 5/8" intermediate casing will be run and cemented. If commercial production is found, a string of 5 1/2" production casing will be run and the well completed.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

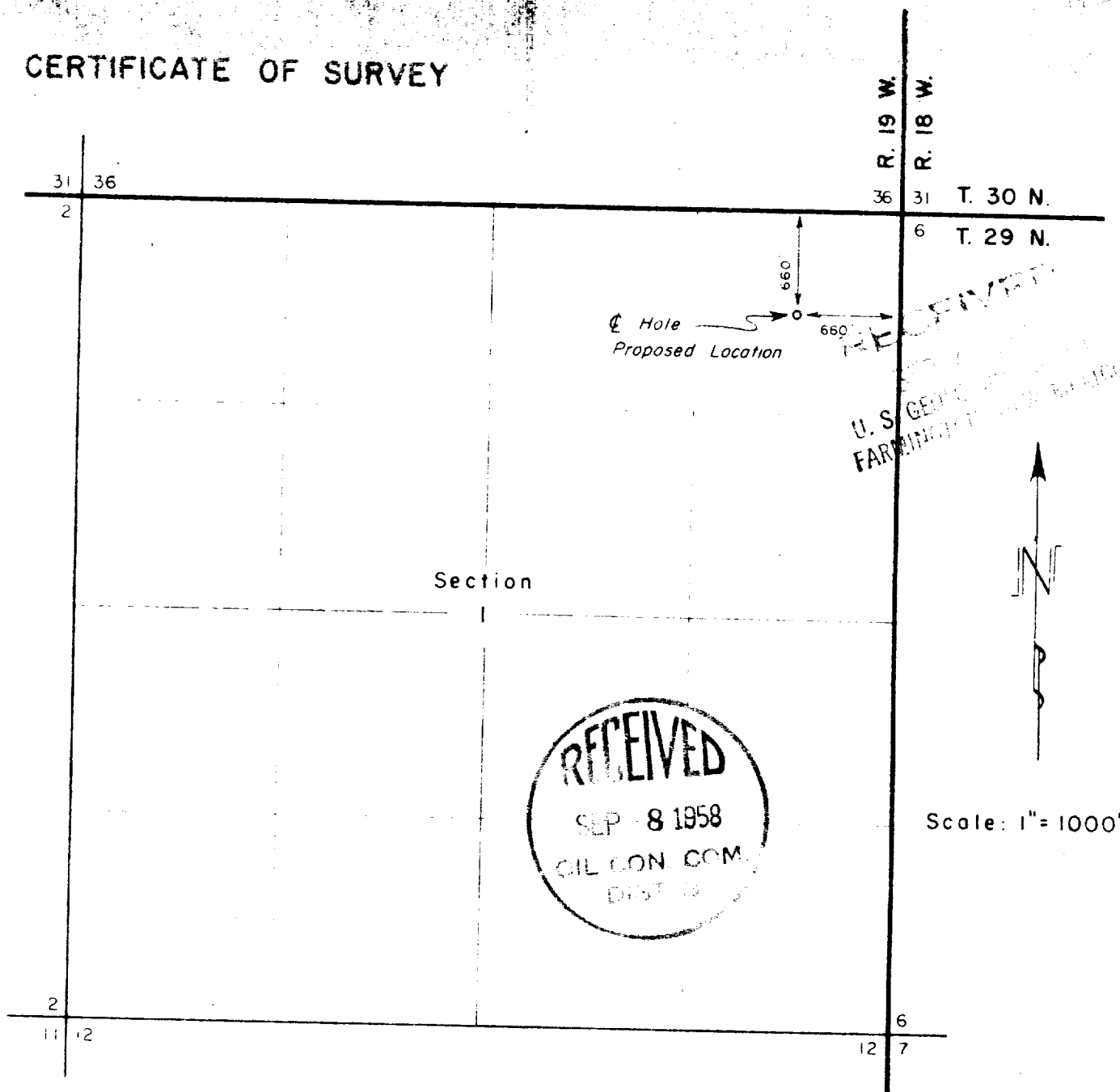
