Dear Sir:

On 10/30/55 a Deliverability Test was submitted to your Aztec office for the Delhi-Taylor Howell No.1 K 20-30N-8W Blanco-Mesaverde cas well. This test was calculated using the Pw measured seven days following completion of the well and the deliverability was 904 MCFPD. On 11/11/55, a second Deliverability Test was submitted for the same well and was calculated using a Pw measured seven days following the deliverability test flow period. This deliverability amounted to 1,025 MCFPD.

At the time that the first test was submitted, the final order had not yet reached me and there was some confusion as to which shut-in pressure could be used to determine the deliverability for the initial potential test. The second test was submitted within the forty-five day deadline for initial potential tests and it was thought that this test would be used to determine allowables during the remainder of that prorationing period.

It is therefore requested that the allowables for this well during the first prorationing period be recalculated using the deliverability obtained on the second test.
